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A Collation of Cambridge Corpus Christi College 71 (Macrobius *Saturnalia*)

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**Abstract:** Cambridge Corpus Christi College 71 (= C), written in the twelfth century (St. Albans), can be shown to be a *gemellus* of Cambridge University Library Ff.3.5, also written in the twelfth century (Bury St. Edmunds). Used by Gronovius and judged by La Penna (1953) one of the three most important witnesses to the family  $\beta_2$ , C was ignored by Willis in his Teubner edition. A and C together provide useful evidence, parallel with the earlier Vatican Reginensis latinus 2043 (= R, s. X ex. / s. XI in., Mont St. Michel), for one segment of  $\beta_2$ . A collation of C is published here for the first time.

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## A Collation of Cambridge Corpus Christi College 71

Cambridge Corpus Christi College 71 (= C), written at St. Albans in the twelfth century, can be shown to be a *gemellus* of another twelfth-century MS, Cambridge University Library Ff.3.5 (C, written at Bury St. Edmunds). Used by Gronovius and judged by La Penna (1953) one of the three most important witnesses to the family  $\beta_2$ , C was ignored by Willis in his Teubner. A and C together provide useful evidence, parallel with the earlier Vatican Reginensis latinus 2043 (= R), for one segment of  $\beta_2$ . A collation of C is published here for the first time.

Beyond C, I cite the testimony of all the manuscripts used by Willis (including the negligible Madrid MS Z but excluding the still more negligible Madrid MS T), the manuscripts GL published in Carton 1966, and two MSS (OK) published in one of the companion pieces to this paper ('A Collation of British Library Cotton Vit. C.III and Vatican Palatinus latinus 886'). So that the forest might not be obscured by the trees, I list the peculiar errors of C separately at the end of this collection.
