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A Collation of British Library Cotton Vit. C.III and Vatican Palatinus latinus 886 (Macrobius *Saturnalia*)

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Abstract: British Library Cotton Vitellius C.III (= O, s. IX^{3/4}, northern France) comprises Books 1-3 of Macrobius' *Saturnalia*. Ignored by James Willis in his Teubner edition, it can be shown to be an older sibling of Vatican latinus 5207 (L, s. X^{1/4}), a collation of which was published by M. J. Carton: O and L together provide important new evidence for the constitution of family β_1 . A collation of O is published here for the first time. Vatican Palatinus latinus 886 (= K, s. IX in., Lorsch) is also affiliated with β_1 and provides a set of excerpts from *Saturnalia* 1-3. K was used by Ludwig Jan in his landmark edition; a partial collation was published by K. Tohill.

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A Collation of British Library Cotton Vit. C.III and Vatican Palatinus latinus 886

British Library Cotton Vitellius C.III (= O) was written in northen France in about the third quarter of the ninth century and—like the other members of the family (β_1) to which it belongs—comprises Books 1-3 of Macrobius' *Saturnalia* (fol. 86-138). Ignored by James Willis in his Teubner edition, it can be shown to be an older sibling of Vatican latinus 5207 (s. X^{1/4} = L), a collation of which was published by M. J. Carton in her doctoral dissertation (Carton 1966); a collation of O is published here for the first time. Read together with L, O provides important new evidence for the constitution of β_1 .

Vatican Palatinus latinus 886 (= K), written at Lorsch at the start of the ninth century, is also affiliated with β_1 and provides a set of excerpts from *Saturnalia* 1-3 (fol. 125-41 = 1. II. 2-1. II. 43 on slaves + 2.1.7-2.7.11 on jokes + 3.13.11-3.20.8 on foods). K was used by Ludwig Jan in his landmark edition (Jan 1852); a partial collation was published in Tohill 1978. I provide a full collation here for the record but do not intend to cite K regularly in my edition.

Beyond C, I cite the testimony of all the manuscripts used by Willis (including the negligible Madrid MS Z but excluding the still more negligible Madrid MS T), the manuscripts GL published in Carton 1966, and the Cambridge MS (C) published in one of the companion pieces to this paper ('A Collation of Cambridge Corpus Christi College 71'). I have generally not included those places where the text of all the MSS requires emendation: for a full listing of such passages see the paper just mentioned. So that the forest might not be obscured by the trees, I list the peculiar errors of O and K (as they appear to be, given the current state of our knowledge) separately at the end of this collection.

the error of VOL is original, resulting from simple *saut du même au même*, the scribe seeing (and perhaps beginning to write) 'fulgor', with his eye then jumping to 'fulgeret'; M's 'ne fulgor refulgeret' could then be explained as a botched attempt at suppletion, B's 'ne fulgor nefulgeret' a further error based on the latter, and Z's 'ne

B's 'ne fulgor nefulgeret' reflects the original error, resulting from omission of a line containing 'lumen per umoris aerii densitatem tamquam e cuiusdam partus progressio' (this is C. E. Murgia's suggestion). The reading 'ne fulgor refulgeret' would then be a 'correction', and 'ne fulgeret' would be an error arising from 'ne fulgor ne fulgerest' by a form of haplography (Z's 'ne fulgerent' would again be a further corruption of V's reading).

The second is by some distance preferable, I think
